BC Services Card

The new eCRC system utilizes the BC Services Card as Electronic Identity Verification (EIV). Applying for a Criminal Record Check Online

You will be directed to log on to <u>https://justice.gov.bc.ca/criminalrecordcheck</u> Follow the directions outlined on the Ministry of Justice Criminal Record Check webpage. When asked to enter the access code provided by your organization use the Access Code: G964GTY26F

You will be required to pay for your application. Your application will take approximately two weeks to process.

Sharing the result of a Completed Criminal Record Check

If you have had a Criminal record check completed within the last 5 years through the Ministry of Justice Criminal Records Review Program that is for the same type of check you can share the results with NIC.
